Join North Shore Area Scouts in celebrating the **40th Anniversary** of the B-P Trail. Hike the 42 km trail and collect the specially designed, limited edition, five-piece commemorative badge. Kick start your program with weekend hikes and have fun as you enjoy the four sections of the spectacular North Shore B-P Trail.

Black Mountain – Horseshoe Bay to Cypress Bowl (5 to 7 hours)

Hollyburn – Cypress Bowl to Cleveland Dam (4 to 5 hours)

Grouse Mountain – Cleveland Dam (Grouse Sky Ride) to Lynn Valley Suspension Bridge (3.5 to 4.5 hours)

Mount Seymour - Lynn Valley Suspension Bridge to Deep Cove
(3.5 to 4.5 hours)

October with five weekends is your first opportunity to complete the challenge. The trail can be hiked through out the year, aside from the higher elevations in the winter months.

The trail is challenging and most suited for Scout aged youth and older. In the Spirit of Scouting, all sections are invited to come out and take the challenge and hike a part of the trail to the best of your abilities.
